- Collaborative academic programs and services involving the library enhance student learning.***

Academic libraries enhance student learning through the campus, such as the writing center, academic enrichment, and research lab, yield the benefits for students (e.g., higher grade, academic confidence, retention).

- Information literacy instruction strengthens general education outcomes.***
